USA National Soccer Teams



2009 is a very important year for both the Men's and Women's National Soccer Teams.

Men The Men are competing to qualify for the 2010 World Cup which will be held in several cities in South Africa. The current level is called 'Hex' because six teams are playing each other at home and away between February and October. We defeated Mexico 2-0 in Columbus, OH last month. A few BSC members and players attended that intense rivalry game. The next game will be at El Salvador on March 28 at 9:00 PM. Since this coincides with the Soccer Players Mexican dinner, the game will be available on the big screen at the Club. On April 1, Trinidad & Tobago will visit Nashville, TN and again, a number of members and players will be attending the game.

The remainder of the 'Hex' schedule is as follows:

At Costa Rico on June 3 At Chicago against Honduras on June 6 At Mexico on August 12

At Salt Lake against El Salvador on September 5 At Trinidad & Tobago on September 9

At Honduras on October 10 At Washington DC against Costa Rico on October 14

All games that are shown on television will be available on the big screen. Details will be available in future newsletters. Let's support our team as they move towards qualifying for the World Cup.

Also in June the Men's National Team will be participating in the Confederations Cup and in the first level of play we drew the 'Group of Death'. We will be playing Italy (current World Cup Champion) on June 15, Brazil (5-time World Cup Champion) on June 18, and Egypt (current African Champion) on June 21. Further play will be determined by how well we do in these three games.

Women The Women's National Team just completed a second place finish during the Algarve Cup held in Portugal. We defeated Denmark 2-0, Iceland 1-0 and Norway 1-0 to reach the Final. We lost to Sweden (1-1) on penalty kicks. Our Keeper, Hope Solo was named MVP of the tournament. They will play Japan in May in their next game.

The big news is that a new Women's World Professional Soccer League has been developed to be played in the United States between March 29 and August 22, 2009.

There will be teams and players from around the world. Some games will be televised and details will be available at the Club.
